A Letter from the Chair

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I want to say, from the bottom of my heart, thank you. Thank you for the many hours you have volunteered; thank you for the important skills you have contributed; and thank you, thank you for the critical funds you have given. It is because of your generous support that we have been able to continue and even grow our in-home parent education programs, to provide tangible support for families, and to help ensure Oklahoma children have safer, healthier, and happier childhoods.

It has been an exciting and eventful year at Parent Promise. We welcomed our new Executive Director, Christina Siemens, in June. She comes to us from Tulsa, where she most recently served as the Executive Director of Fostering Connections. Chris has spent decades working with child- and family-focused nonprofits and state agencies, and she has hit the ground running with Parent Promise.

We also launched a brand new home-visiting program, Children First, Oklahoma Nurse-Family Partnership at Parent Promise. Operating in conjunction with the Oklahoma Department of Health, we provide first-time mothers with in-home visits from our specially trained nurses, beginning in early pregnancy and continuing through the child's second birthday. This program is designed to ensure participants receive the prenatal care, parenting skills education, and other resources they need, empowering them to care both for themselves and for their new babies.

We started several new community engagement efforts, including programming lunch and learns. We are partnering in an endeavor to learn more about the challenges families faced during the pandemic and the tools they need now to fill the gaps. We renewed our charter as the Oklahoma chapter of Prevent Child Abuse America, added new board members, and added several nurses and educators to our excellent staff.

As you will see in this report, even through a global pandemic and a round of state budget cuts, we have not just survived: we have thrived. Thanks to your invaluable support, we can continue our work to promote healthier childhoods and brighter futures for Oklahoma children.

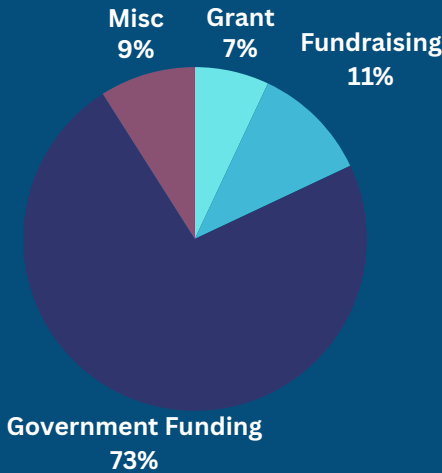

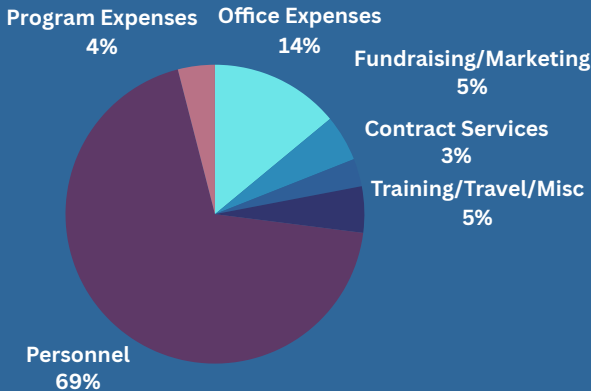
